1. Demonstrate proper insertion of the i-Gel Airway in a simulated patient using an appropriate airway mannequin.
2. Demonstrate appropriate confirmation techniques to ensure proper tube placement, including the use of secondary devices such as a colorimetric CO2 device.
3. Demonstrate proper documentation of airway placement, including indications, device used, size, complications, time, confirmations, and effects.
